THE BROOKSIDE PARENT CLUB ENDORSES MEASURE B

On November's ballot, we will have the chance to vote on Measure B, a bond measure aimed at raising \$289 million to repair and upgrade high school facilities in the Tamalpais High School District. The Brookside Parent Club is joining **many other parent clubs** across the Tam District to endorse the measure because it directly affects the experience of our own children, as they will feed into the Tamalpais High School District for high school. If you want to learn more about the bond, **visit this website**, but it's important to know that if this bond does not pass, the District will have to cut from their operating budget to cover roofing and HVAC safety-related repairs. This would mean drastic cuts to teachers and programs as early as next year. Bond measures are the only practical way to fund school repairs in California and typically are only proposed every 20 years. We encourage you to support this to set your own children up for success when they get to high school!
